1. **TIRES**

3. **YARD WASTE/ Tree limbs, brush clippings, leaves, grass clippings**
4. **APPLIANCES-at additional cost-compressors must be removed**
5. **PAINT CANS-emptied and dried out-no liquids-lids off**
6. **OIL-no oil or oil containers**
7. **BATTERIES-vehicle—place on top of load—notify office**
8. **NO HAZARDOUS MATERIAL**
9. **NO CONCRETE—large amounts must be in separate load**
10. **NO FUEL TANKS OF ANY TYPE**
11. **NO RAILROAD TIES**
12. **ENGINE BLOCK—drain oil**
13. **LAWN MOWERS—ok to take—drain gas and oil**

What We Do NOT Accept

Items Not Accepted

- Microwaves, toasters, and other small kitchen appliances
- Refrigerators, stoves, and other large appliances
- Broken TVs (broken glass or otherwise dismantled)
- Air conditioning units
- Lamps/Light bulbs
- Vacuum and floor cleaners
- Toys
- General rubbish
- Audio and Video Cassettes
- CDs and DVDs
- Software
- Carbon Monoxide/Smoke detectors
- Bathroom devices (ie. electric razors, toothbrushes, etc.)
- Gas Powered Tools
- Glass, Christmas Light Bulbs, etc
- Mercury Thermometers
- Thermostats
- Aerosol cans
- Lava Lamps
- Pressurized canisters of any kind
- Live ammunition
- Needles of any sort
- Adhesives, Paints, Chemicals of any kind
- Alkaline Batteries (AA, AAA, C, D, etc...)
- Pre-lit Christmas trees

What We Recycle (Fees depend on residency)

Fees depend on place of residence listed on driver's license. Residents of Christian county can recycle these items free of charge. You must bring a valid driver's license to verify residency. Those living outside of the participating areas are charged a fee of \$20 for standard CRT TVs and \$10 per CRT monitor. Projection TVs and console TVs are \$40. Please call your local store if you have any questions about fees. If you would like your area to be listed and receive electronics recycling for these items free of charge, please contact your village or county officials.

NOTE: The Jacksonville store can only accept CRT devices with a screen size 32 inches diagonally or less. Jacksonville does not accept projection TVs or console TVs. They can still accept flat screen LCD and plasma TVs of any size. For larger items, please take them to our Springfield location. Same fees and guidelines apply.
